DEAR GLOBAL INTERCESSORS

Welcome to this prayer booklet specifically crafted for you to understand the purpose of Global Intercessors and to guide you on what to pray for in this season. I am truly excited about your passion for intercession and pray that this booklet is able to support you on this journey. In this note to you, I will outline who we are as Global Intercessors and the values that hold us together. I will share some of my convictions on why we need to lead lives of prayer and intercession, and how these are essential in transforming our lives, families, churches, communities, nation, Israel and other nations around us.

Global Intercessors is a non-denominational, non-profit network of intercessors with a mandate to intercede for the globe. We pray without ceasing and have created a 24/7 platform on Zoom which allows intercessors from all over Zimbabwe and the world to pray. Our vision is to unite Christians from around the globe in prayer, fasting and intercession. Additionally it is to train and instruct the Church to pray and intercede, bringing transformation in all areas of life to further Christ's Kingdom. Our mission is to be a global movement, focusing on prayer and fasting for spiritual revival across the globe. Global Intercessors is birthed out of a vision God gave my husband and I, when we started the work of assisting orphaned children through what is now Higherlife Foundation. The vison is based on the prophetic word given by Cindy Jacobs for the nation of Zimbabwe in 1998 and the subsequent scripture we received to implement the vision, Isaiah 61. It is this scripture which acts as our guide in all we pray for as Global Intercessors and what my husband and I implement through our private companies and social impact work.

Importance of Prayer and Intercession

The Importance of Prayer and Intercession

I believe the importance of prayer and intercession is succinctly captured in a quote by John Wesley which says:

"God does nothing but by prayer, and everything with it."

Therefore:

- Nothing is more foundational to who we are at Global Intercessors than the principles of prayer and intercession. This is our starting place and everything we do flows from our belief in the power of prayer.
- We understand that the transforming work God has done in us is not only for us, but also for the community. Our families, jobs, communities and nations are opportunities for God's kingdom to be displayed. We realise God's principles not only work within the walls of the church, but that He has principles that can benefit every area of society.
- Intercession moves beyond personal conversation with God about our own thoughts, desires, and needs. It opens the way for us to approach God with the needs of other people, even other nations.
- We do not rely on our own strength, thoughts and abilities as we intercede and implement our strategy, but on the power and anointing of the Holy Spirit
- Prayer and intercession put us in a place to see and implement God's perspective, rather than relying on our own perceptions.

- 8 "For I, the Lord, love justice;I hate robbery and wrongdoing.In my faithfulness I will reward my people



STAND UNSHAKEN, DECLARING IN FAITH

It is a crucial time for us to individually and collectively seek God's divine intervention for the challenges facing our nation, Zimbabwe. We need to pray not only for our nation, but we need to pray for our leaders, for all those who govern us, that they will turn to God with humble hearts and follow Him.

Many people believe that Zimbabwe has reached a point of no return. As we pray, we ought to stand unshaken, declaring in faith that with God, nothing is impossible. No problem is too great for Him. Seasons of distress and uncertainty and hardship call for faithful, fervent prayer by God's people and remind us of our responsibility to humble ourselves before Almighty God. We cannot expect healing to come to our nation apart from obedience to God through His Holy Word.

- Pray that as a nation we would return to God. As we call on God, let us do so by genuine faith, believing that He hears our prayers.
- Pray for the Church to continue to see the need to repent of personal and national sins in the fear of the Lord.
- Pray that Christians across the nation will persist in seeking and implementing God's purpose for Zimbabwe, and that God, in His mercy, will usher in transforming revival.
- Pray that the Church would rise and speak with one voice as stipulated in the National Vision Document, "The Zimbabwe We Want" to implement the goals and objectives of the Vision given to our spiritual fathers

CALL FOR PERSONAL REPENTANCE

Let the Holy Spirit draw you into God's presence and respond to Him as He speaks to you. Open your heart and your life to Him during this time of intercession. Effective intercession must include personal confession. Before we begin in intercession, it's good to inspect our own hearts and come clean before the Lord. Take time to confess and repent to God of any sins in your life.

If we claim to be without sin, we deceive ourselves and the truth is not in us. If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just and will forgive us our sins and purify us from all unrighteousness. If we claim we have not sinned, we make him out to be a liar and his word has no place in our lives (I John 1:8-10).

- Humbly confess and repent to God for any sins in your life.
- Ask the Holy Spirit to reveal areas He is displeased with in your life.
- Pray according to 1 John 1:9 knowing that; "If you confess your sins, he is faithful and just and will forgive your sins and purify you from all unrighteousness."

"...Let us throw off everything that hinders and the sin that so easily entangles..." Hebrews 12:1



NATIONAL REPENTANCE

Nehemiah, prior to being anointed to rebuild the walls, confessed his own sins, the sins of his father's house, and his nation's sins. There are three sins which make God judge a nation and these include idolatry, shedding of blood and forbidden sexual relations. Having repented, he could later say that the joy of the Lord was his strength. As Zimbabweans we acknowledge and confess the evil deeds committed in our nation particularly by our leaders, in church and at political level, and that as a nation we need to repent. We cannot continue to be unrepentant and continue in our sinful ways.

Placing ourselves under the blood of the Lamb of God and as the Spirit of God leads, let us; repent of our national sin, renounce the same, revoke the enemy's power over the nation and rededicate Zimbabwe to God.

- Repent for the worship of any false gods, occult, ancestral worship or participation of our leaders both in the church and in the public sector, in any false religious activities. Use Daniel 9:1-19 as your guide.
- Repent for any covenants that were entered into at national level by our leaders, where the country and its people were dedicated to false gods.
- Repent for the blood that has been shed in our nation. Ask the Lord to forgive our nation for embracing bloodshed and allowing injustice to prevail in our midst.
- Repent for sexual immorality amongst our leaders both in the church in the public sphere including adultery and the acceptance of "small houses" as legitimate forms of marriage
- Repent for the acts of injustice and corruption that continue to occur in our nation. Repent for rejecting God as a nation, for throwing God out of our schools and government.

"If my people, which are called by my name, shall humble themselves, and pray, and seek my face, and turn from their wicked ways; then will I hear from heaven, and will forgive their sin, and will heal their land" 2 Chronicles 7:14



PRAY FOR THE CHURCH

Jesus is the only answer to our nation's problems. We need a fresh move of His Spirit to bring revival to the church and another Great Awakening to this land. No politician has the answers for our nation, but we must pray for godly leadership in every position of authority. The Church arose to pray, repent and intercede through the 90 Day National Prayer which took place from 1 June to 29 August 2020! We must continue, as the Church, to cry out for a mighty move of the Spirit to sweep across our nation so that people turn to the Lord. The Word says, "Blessed is the nation whose God is the Lord" Psalm 33:12

- We pray for the continued building of a strong, bold and united church in Zimbabwe that knows that faith can and will do infinitely more than any person, law, bill or platform could ever do.
- Ask the Lord, for a spiritual awakening that gives life to our land. Call us once again in this time of great challenge to honor you with great vigor. Ask the Lord to teach us how to love one another.
- Pray that the barriers that prevent churches from working together for the advancement of the Gospel are being broken as we continue to come together to pray and that the church in Zimbabwe is rising up in unity of faith and purpose.

And I also say to you that you are Peter, and on this rock I will build my church, and the gates of Hades shall not prevail against it. And I will give you the keys of the kingdom of heaven, and whatever you bind on earth will be bound in heaven, and whatever you loose on earth will be loosed in heaven."

EVANGELICAL FELLOWSHIP OF ZIMBABWE (EFZ)

In Zimbabwe, the GI Mission is implemented in line with the Evangelical Fellowship of Zimbabwe (EFZ) vision, to impact the nation by obeying the Great Commission. Founded in 1962, EFZ brings together 923 evangelicals to preach the Gospel, equip church leaders to facilitate fellowship and joint ministry, and meet the needs of vulnerable communities.

Additionally, the EFZ plays a very crucial role in influencing nation building in Zimbabwe. In 2006, moved by the daily sufferings of the people as the economy took a plunge, the EFZ together with the Catholic Bishops Conference (CBC) and the Zimbabwe Christian Council (ZCC) led a nationwide consultative process documenting and crafting a national vision popularly known as "The Zimbabwe We Want." The document sets out the shared vision of the values, socio-economic and political characteristics the Church wants for Zimbabwe.

- Pray for wisdom for the current President of the EFZ, Bishop Muparutsa, as he leads the consultations with the Government on the Zimbabwe We Want
- Pray that the President of Zimbabwe and his Government will humble themselves and accept the Zimbabwe We Want National Vision as a guide for rebuilding the nation of Zimbabwe
- Pray for all the EFZ Past Presidents, thanking God for their role in the formulation and implementation of the Zimbabwe We Want





EXERCISING OUR DOMINION IN CHRIST

God gave the dominion of the earth to humans forever. He releases His power in Zimbabwe in response to the Church calling on Him to do so through intercession and worship. The Spirit moves in response to what we as God's people say and do. As believers we must exercise our authority in Christ to release in Zimbabwe the victory that Jesus secured on the cross. God's Word is our weapon. We resist Satan and his plans for our nation by speaking the Word and retain the ground we take from him by standing firm on the word.

When we pray according to God's will, our prayers reach His throne and find approval, resulting in the release of power. We must know who we are in Christ and the authority we possess in Jesus. We must take our place of authority in Christ as those seated in heavenly places with Jesus.

- We pray for the 7 Mountains namely the Church, Family, Government, Commerce, Media, Arts, and Education, that the Word of God would permeate these sectors and determine how people relate and how business and work is done
- Proclaim the things you desire to see concerning the 7 Mountains, the type of heads in the Church, families, Businesses and Government.
- Pray that Christians will take responsibility for the salvation and discipleship of the people in these 7 Mountains
- Pray that as the Church, we take leadership over the rebuilding of the nation and that all Christians rally behind the National Vision articulated by our spiritual fathers in the "Zimbabwe We Want Document"

WISDOM & DISCERNMENT IN THE CHURCH

The Church is often relegated to the sidelines, considered irrelevant and out of touch with the socio-economic and political issues in our nation. The Church should however be leading the nation in wisdom and discernment for the future. Nothing is achieved in the kingdom of God without warfare.

There is need for us to push in prayer for the commitment of the Church, the Political Leaders and the public in general, to the National Vision for Zimbabwe as contained in "**Zimbabwe We Want**" document.

- Intercede for the Church, that the fear of man would fall away and that they would boldly proclaim the Word of God as the standard of our nation.
- Pray that as the Church engages with the political leadership, it is not enticed and forced to compromise
- Pray that the Church would clearly demonstrate that it is the light and salt of the world as it leads the nation in nation building
- Pray for courage to speak out and that the Church would not stay silent in the face of injustice but do all things through the Lord's wisdom and love.
- Pray for all church leadership by name, asking God to grant them wisdom and ability to make the Church a vessel for healing and revival in Zimbabwe.
- Ask God to break any fear off you so that are able to share the love of God with those around you and that you would boldly seek solutions to the challenges in our nation.

TRANSFORMATION IN EVERY AREA OF LIFE

Do we truly believe that a good, wise and perfect God is interested in us as Zimbabweans, cares about our challenges and has a wise, good and perfect solution for our nation? We believe God has a solution and that solution is contained in the document "The Zimbabwe We Want". We have been praying for a long time and God spoke through our spiritual fathers. The National Vision contained in this document was prepared by the Zimbabwe Catholic Bishop's Conference (ZCBC), the Evangelical Fellowship of Zimbabwe (EFZ) and the Zimbabwe Council of Church (ZCC).

There are some who do not believe this document is God ordained mainly because they say that the Church should not be involved in politics. However, the nature of the Gospel demands that we be involved in the transformation of the social, economic and political systems or environment within which God's people live. The God that we know in Jesus Christ is a God of love, justice, peace, and reconciliation and He has made us ambassadors of these divine values.

- Pray that all Christians rally behind the National Vision to transform our nation in every area of life, political, education, health, business, rural areas, media, arts, education etc.
- Make declarations of faith that we may are patient, not expecting the nation to turn around in a short while but believing that God is faithful to His vision of the kingdom of God being established in Zimbabwe. Declare that believers will not be discouraged or disheartened and that they will be fully persuaded that what God has promised, He is also able to perform."

Know therefore that the LORD your God is God, the faithful God who keeps covenant and steadfast love with those who love him and keep his commandments, to a thousand generations. Deuteronomy 7:9

PRAY FOR THE ECONOMY

Extreme poverty is estimated to have risen from 29% in 2018 to 34% in 2019, an increase from 4.7 to 5.7 million people. The increase is driven by economic contraction and the sharp rise in prices of food and basic commodities. With Covid-19 the population figure for extreme poverty is projected to reach 8.6 million.

Rural areas are home to **67 percent** at least two-thirds of Zimbabwe's population, including **79 percent** of the poor and **92 percent** of the extremely poor.

- Pray for businesses to respond to the financial needs in our communities by providing jobs and helping to decrease the nation's high unemployment rate.
- Pray for a healthy recovery in all sectors of the economy and that a spiritual awakening will take place that helps overcome greed, corruption and dishonesty.
- Intercede and ask God to establish righteousness in the economy, expose corruption, and bring to justice those who have sinned against God and the nation.
- Ask God to heal the economy.
- Intercede that a great revival will break out in the marketplace as a result of the shaking. Pray that God will begin to give wisdom in the midst of the shaking to shift the wealth of Zimbabwe into the hands of the righteous.

Elisha said, "Listen! God's word! The famine's over. This time tomorrow food will be plentiful—a handful of meal for a shekel; two handfuls of grain for a shekel. The market at the city gate will be buzzing."

STATE OWNED ENTERPRISES AND PARASTATALS

State-owned enterprises and parastatals (SEPs) play an important role in the Zimbabwean economy, but their poor financial and operational performance has limited their impact. In 1980, Zimbabwe had just 20 SEPs. Despite privatization undertaken since the 1990s, that number has since risen to 107. Just 43 of Zimbabwe's 107 SEPs are wholly commercial enterprises. Most Zimbabwean SEPs operate at a loss and require public subsidies to remain solvent—and some have accumulated significant tax arrears.

The central government wage bill alone is equivalent to 90% of public revenue and 66% of public spending. This focus involves praying for a spiritual awakening in the Zimbabwean public sector.

- We humble ourselves before the Lord's throne of grace according to Joel 2 and ask for forgiveness for our arrogance in believing we can turn around our economy without His help.
- Pray for the Lord's covenant blessings to be restored to us personally and to this land.
- Pray for state enterprises that will be built on a foundation of high moral and ethical standards.
- Ask the Lord to heal our land and our economy. The Lord's Kingdom is not lacking of resources, there is in fact an abundance.
- Pray that as a nation that the windows of Heaven would open up and mercifully release the Lord's glorious riches into the economy.

"Take this most seriously: A yes on earth is yes in heaven; a no on earth is no in heaven. What you say to one another is eternal. I mean this. When two of you get together on anything at all on earth and make a prayer of it, my Father in heaven goes into action. And when two or three of you are together because of me, you can be sure that I'll be there."

UNEMPLOYMENT

Unemployment in Zimbabwe ranks among the highest in the world. Millions of Zimbabweans struggle with unemployment. Every year, Zimbabwe produces more than 10 000 graduates in Zimbabwe, from different universities, polytechnic colleges, nursing schools and teachers but the majority of them fail to get employment and have to try and make ends meet through entrepreneurial initiatives or working in the informal sector.

With an average age of 19, it is critical that we pray and declare that there will be a miraculous turn around to the level of unemployment in the country. God can change any situation!

- We pray for the unemployed. Intercede for individuals you know of "by name" who have either never been employed or lost their jobs and are struggling financially.
- Ask God to open opportunities for them to find meaningful employment. Additionally, pray that Christians will not allow challenges of unemployment to discourage them but pray that in the midst of trying times they would continue to rejoice and take joy in the God of their salvation.
- We pray that the economy will be turned around, and everyone that wants a job will find a job, and that we will be prosperous as a nation, with a thriving manufacturing sector and employment opportunities for the youth.

Though the fig tree should not blossom, nor fruit be on the vines, the produce of the olive fail and the fields yield no food, the flock be cut off from the fold and there be no herd in the stalls, yet I will rejoice in the LORD; I will take joy in the God of my salvation.

Habakkuk 3:17-18



INFORMAL SECTOR

So many Zimbabweans have turned to the informal sector to make ends meet. They are operating their business under very challenging conditions such as lack of proper and adequate infrastructure, funding as well as fixed locations to do business from. Recently many were driven into abject poverty needing food and other forms of assistance, following the COVID-19 pandemic and the related lockdown restrictions. We want to speak life into the informal sector in Zimbabwe today.

- Pray for struggling businesses all over the country to find creative ways of doing business.
- Pray for Christian business owners in the informal sector who are confronted on a daily basis by unethical, corrupt and unlawful business practices. Pray that they would not compromise but they would stand firm in the word believing that the Lord will never leave them nor forsake them.
- Pray for the development of the informal sector, for small businesses to obtain access to funding, training opportunities and access to bigger markets
- Pray that they access food and other basic necessities during this period and that their business recover following the uplifting of restrictions put in place to curb the COVID-19 pandemic

Then they gave money to the masons and carpenters, and gave food and drink and olive oil to the people of Sidon and Tyre, so that they would bring cedar logs by sea from Lebanon to Joppa, as authorized by Cyrus king of Persia" Ezra 4:7 NIV



BANKING SECTOR

The banking sector has shown signs of stress since early 2016. Cash shortages developed in early 2016, forcing banks to limit both cash withdrawals and import payments. The cash crisis also increased premiums for cash payments. Depositors have been unable to fully access their money from banks and this has caused long queues outside banks.

We must believe that God knows, cares, and responds to our needs. We build ourselves up with the Word of God. There is no doubt about our Father and His capabilities. In the midst of the cash crisis, we can turn to Scripture to encourage us each day.

- Pray for supernatural wisdom in the national Ministry of Finance, the Zimbabwe Stock Exchange and the banking sector during these economic times.
- Pray that God will raise up a banking sector based upon biblical principles. Pray for the banking sector in our nation to operate in a godly and just manner.
- Pray that these entities and individuals responsible for making designs about the banking sector practice integrity, justice, and that all unethical or corrupt practices would be supernaturally halted.

He said to me, "Prophesy over these bones: 'Dry bones, listen to the Message of God!" God, the Master, told the dry bones, "Watch this: I'm bringing the breath of life to you and you'll come to life. HEALTHCARE

The poor, the orphaned and the widowed remain the ones most affected by lack of access to healthcare and poor households continue to defer medical care because of rising fees. Our healthcare system has over the years deteriorated tremendously and we have also seen either many doctors and nurses leaving the country or going on strikes, and this has caused massive shortages of healthcare professionals in our hospitals and clinics. The health situation has also been worsened by the outbreak of the COVID-19 pandemic. We have lost many Zimbabwean babies due to poor maternity facilities and many adults as well due to outbreaks of cholera and typhoid over the years and we are facing ever-increasing shortages of medication.

There is nothing that the Lord cannot restore and our declaration today is that the Lord can and will revive and restore the public healthcare system in Zimbabwe.

- Decree the type of healthcare system you desire to see in the nation
- Pray for all those who are currently struggling to afford to access the healthcare system.
- Pray not only for the men, women, and children who are suffering from the lack of quality healthcare in Zimbabwe, but also for the nurses, doctors and medical support staff who lack the necessary wages and protective equipment to protect them from pandemic diseases such as COVID-19
- Pray for the strength, compassion, and joy of all the staff in the hospitals and clinics who have to care for patients sometimes under very tough conditions

THE AGRICULTURAL SECTOR

Once the breadbasket of Africa, Zimbabwe's agricultural sector has had declining output over the past two decades. Agriculture plays a critical role in Zimbabwe's economy. About two thirds of Zimbabweans work in agriculture and food security is intimately linked to agricultural production. Although its contribution to GDP has fallen from 19% in 2008 to around 10%-12% more recently, the sector remains a top priority under the Government's Transitional Stabilisation Programme (TSP, covering October, 2018 to December, 2020).

- Pray for sustainable solutions to resuscitate Zimbabwe's Agricultural sector. In recent years, productivity has declined drastically and the country is unable to feed itself.
- Pray for the Church to spearhead capacity building of rural farming communities.
- Pray that small holder farmers would be equipped to go beyond subsistence farming to a place where they can generate revenue from their farm produce.
- Pray for innovative farming methods to be implemented that will raise Zimbabwe to once again be the breadbasket of Africa. Nothing is too hard for the Lord.

Does the farmer plow continually to plant seed? Does he continually turn and harrow the ground? Does he not level its surface And sow dill and scatter cummin And plant wheat in rows, Barley in its place and rye within its area? For his God instructs and teaches him properly.

- Pray for all levels of education—from younger children in pre-schools and primary schools and high schools through more advanced education, including university students.
- Pray for an awakening among students of all ages as well as for their teachers. When possible pray "by name" for students and teachers you know.
- Pray that godly principles will come into the curriculum being taught at all levels of education.
- Pray for those responsible for shaping curriculum, that God will mould the information being taught.
- Our schools will be a joy, a praise and a glory before all the nations of the earth! Nations will fear God and tremble because of all the goodness, peace, prosperity, security and stability that will be evident in our schools. In Jesus' Name.

Zimbabwe is a youthful country, with approximately **77 per cent** of its 13 million total population under the age of 35. Annual national population growth rate estimates range from **2.4 to 3 percent**, and projections indicate a population of **23 million by 2030**.

We declare that God will use students on campuses' to spark revival and that these revivals would be championed by faithful youth uniting together in fervent prayer.

- Pray God will bring into position student leaders within student bodies, who are like Daniel, Shadrach, Meshach and Abednego—filled with wisdom and understanding because they know their God and understand the principles of His kingdom. (Daniel 1:3-6)
- Pray that students be filled with the knowledge of God's will in all wisdom and spiritual understanding; that they may walk worthy of the Lord, fully pleasing Him, being fruitful in every good work and increasing in the knowledge of God.
- According to Psalm 91, declare that the Lord is our students' refuge. He is their God and their trustworthy place of safety. He will rescue them from every trap, protect them from deadly disease, and make sure no evil overtakes them. The angels protect them wherever they go. (Psalm 91:1-11)

 spirit that wants to manipulate and report news that is either untruthful or slanted to persuade inaccurate
 reporting.

AWAKENING IN THE MEDIA - MEDIA OWNERS AND PERSONNEL

We rely on mass media in our country for the current news and facts about what is important and what we should be aware of. In the face of populist reporting media owners and personnel have compromised on the integrity and/or authenticity of their news in order to remain popular or out of fear.

It is imperative that we pray for the rise of Christian media owners and personnel whose media houses are founded on truth, integrity and the word of God.

- Thank God for placing His Spirit upon the leaders (owners, journalists, actors, film and magazine producers etc. He has placed in the media and His Word on their tongues (2 Samuel 23:2-4). Pray that they are heralds of peace who will bring Good News and proclaim salvation to the nations (Isaiah 52:7).
- Ask God to raise up godly men and women journalists who will champion the cause of the powerless and seek truth and justice (Proverbs 31:8-9).
- Ask, believing that God called media leaders will be bold, fearless and unafraid to expose the truth about wickedness in our nation including those that kill and seek to muffle voices of justice amidst us

- Pray for divine understanding for us and for those in the media who are followers of Jesus, we can have great confidence that truth does not have to be forever out of our reach.
- Thank God for placing His Spirit upon the leaders He has placed in the media and His Word on their tongue (2 Samuel 23:2–4).

- Pray that more devoted, righteous people will seek and be elected to public office, thus helping provide a moral compass for our nation, for where there is no vision, the people perish.
- Pray that God would build a biblical worldview into our present government leaders and those of tomorrow and that they would have the mind of Christ.

PRAY FOR CIVIL SERVANTS

INTEGRITY AND JUSTICE IN GOVERNMENT

THE 13 ATTRIBUTES OF MERCY (EXODUS 34:6-7)

- 1. The Lord! (Adonai)–God is merciful before a person sins! Even though aware that future evil lies dormant within him
- 2. The Lord! (Adonai)–God is merciful after the sinner has gone astray
- 3. God (El)—a name that denotes power as ruler over nature and humankind, indicating that God's mercy sometimes surpasses even the degree indicated by this name
- 4. Compassionate (rahum)–God is filled with loving sympathy for human frailty does not put people into situations of extreme temptation, and eases the punishment of the guilty
- 5. Gracious (v'hanun)–God shows mercy even to those who do not deserve it consoling the afflicted and raising up the oppressed
- 6. Slow to anger (ereh apayim)–God gives the sinner ample time to reflect, improve, and repent
- 7. Abundant in Kindness (v'rav hesed)–God is kind toward those who lack personal merits, providing more gifts and blessings than they deserve; if one's personal behavior is evenly balanced between virtue and sin, God tips the scales of justice toward the good.
- 8. Truth (v'emet)-God never reneges on His word to reward those who serve Him
- 9. Preserver of kindness for thousands of generations (notzeir hesed la-alafim)–God remembers the deeds of the righteous for thebenefit of their less virtuous generations of offspring (thus we constantly invoke the merit of the Patriarchs).
- 10. Forgiver of iniquity (nosei avon)–God forgives intentional sin resulting from an evil disposition, as long as the sinner repents
- 11. Forgiver of willful sin (pesha)–God allows even those who commit a sin with the malicious intent of rebelling against and angering Him the opportunity to repent
- 12. Forgiver of error (v'hata'ah)–God forgives a sin committed out of carelessness, thoughtlessness, or apathy
- 13. Who cleanses (v'nakeh)–God is merciful, gracious, and forgiving, wiping away the sins of those who truly repent; however, if one does not repent, God does not cleanse.



THE SHEMA

The Shema is an affirmation of God's singularity, which reminds us that although we have the Trinity, In fact God is One. (Deuteronomy 6:4-5). We too, as Global Intercessors, join together with the House of Israel to recite this biblical commandment as a demonstration of our faith in the God of Israel alone.
